- Practice 3 days a week—Monday, Wednesday & Friday
- Non-competitive program. No races.
- Emphasis on technique, safety & building tools to become a successful, competitive rower.

Rowing Families:

The following fees give rowers & parents an idea of costs required to participate in the Learn-to-Row Program.

Initial Fees:

Expected at NBRC'S Registration Night

Registration Fee:*	\$250	One time Annual Fee
Monthly Fee:	\$100	Month of September
Initial Total:	\$350	

Monthly Fees:

NBRC charges a monthly fee to each rower over a 9 month period; from September through May. Monthly fees are payable whether or not your rower attends practice.

Registration Fees:

*Registration fees are non-refundable & not pro-rated.

Payment Options:

In Full

In-Full Option A:

Fall Season Monthly Fees + Annual Registration Fee = \$650 *Due at NBRC's Registration Night*

Spring Season Monthly Fees = \$500 *Due in January when the season begins.*

In-Full Option B:

Fall & Spring Season Monthly Fees + Annual Registration Fee = \$1,150 *Due at NBRC's Registration Night*

*In-Full Option C: **Only if your athlete joins in Spring Season***

Spring Season Monthly Fees + Annual Registration Fee = \$750

Payment Schedule

Registration Fee: \$250 Due at NBRC's Registration Night

Monthly Fee: \$100 each month; September through May First month due at NBRC's Registration Night

Credit cards or checks are accepted. Auto-charge service is available.

Uniforms:

No uniform required, but practice t-shirts will be available for purchase.

Other Information:

- *Medical Release:* To be signed by parent.
- *Swim Test:* Mandatory for ALL rowers to be scheduled at Petaluma's E. Washington Public Pool.
- *Code of Conduct:* To be signed by rower & parents.
